Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

This week, following a listing ceremony in St George's Grenada on 26 July 2017, the Grenada Cooperative Bank Limited became the sixteenth company to be listed on the ECSE. The Company's shares are known in the market by its trading symbol, GCBL.
