Eastern Caribbean Securities Market

On the Eastern Caribbean Securities Market the following securities traded:

- 550 Grenada Electricity Services Ltd shares traded at \$10.00; also, 50 Grenada Electricity Services Ltd shares traded odd lot at \$10.00 per share
- 2,250 The Bank of Nevis Ltd shares crossed the market, and
- 24,000 units of the Government of Saint Lucia's 7-year bond, trading symbol LCG070320 crossed the market.
