

# 1.0 Identification and Principal Activity

The Governments of Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, The Commonwealth of Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts-Nevis, St. Lucia and St. Vincent and the Grenadines signed an agreement on 27 May 1994, to establish the Eastern Caribbean Home Mortgage Bank (hereinafter referred to as the "the Bank").

The Eastern Caribbean Home Mortgage Bank was formally established on 19 August 1994, in accordance with Article 40 of the Eastern Caribbean Home Mortgage Bank Agreement, which was incorporated in the Eastern Caribbean Home Mortgage Bank Agreement Act, and subsequently passed in the member territories. The primary office of the Bank is located at Bird Rock, Basseterre, St. Kitts and Nevis.

The principal activity of the Bank is to buy and sell mortgage loans on residential properties, in order to develop and maintain a secondary market in mortgages.

# 2.0 Basis of preparation

The condensed interim financial statements for the three months ended 30 June 2012 have been prepared in accordance with IAS 34, 'Interim financial reporting'. The condensed interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2013, which have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) as issued by the International Accounting Standards Boards (IASB).

There have been no changes in accounting policies since the most recent audited accounts as at 31 March 2013. Any new Accounting Standards of interpretations which became effective in this financial year have had no material impact on the Bank.

# 3. Management's Discussion and Analysis of Financial Condition and Results of Operations

The Company will invest in real estate for its account only in the case of premises for its business operations and property acquired as a default and foreclosure on the mortgage loans. In accordance with prescribed legal procedures,

property acquired through default will be sold, as soon as practicable after acquisition."

An assumption is made, that the term "material commitment" refers to capital expenditure in excess of 1% of the Bank's Total Assets, which totaled \$330.28m at the end of June 30, 2013. The Board of Directors did not approve capital expenditure in excess of \$3.3 million during the period of this review.

# (c) Results of Operation.
